## Gradual Reawakening after Lockdown Hibernation.

## Main Alderman Hall Closed until July 2021

The Alderman Hall in Knightswood Community Centre will be closed until the end of June as major renovation is planned in the next two months. Some youth groups and organisations have decided to wait until the work in the Alderman Hall is completed before restarting their classes.



In the hall, the windows and the outside curtain wall are being replaced. The heating system is being upgraded; this will resolve the hall being cold in the winter months. The bottom row of the new triple glazed windows will be made from obscured glass and this will provide a greater degree of privacy for the activities taking place in the hall. This renovation work was originally intended to be carried out during July last year however it was postponed because of the pandemic.

## Physical Distance Based Capacity (PBDC)

This is the maximum number of people, aged 12 years and older, who can physically distance within each room in Knightswood Community Centre following updated guidance from the Scottish Government. Young people aged 11 and under do not need to physically distance.

- Community Groups are 'not for profit' organisations such as constituted clubs, churches, political party branches and the Community Council.
- Private lets are for individuals or organisations for private purposes or commercial gain.
- Charges for Special Events are dependent on type.
- Licensed bars can be operated within the Centre for Special Events under the authorisation of an occasional license or via mobile bar arrangements. At least six weeks' prior notice is required for occasional licence notice period.
