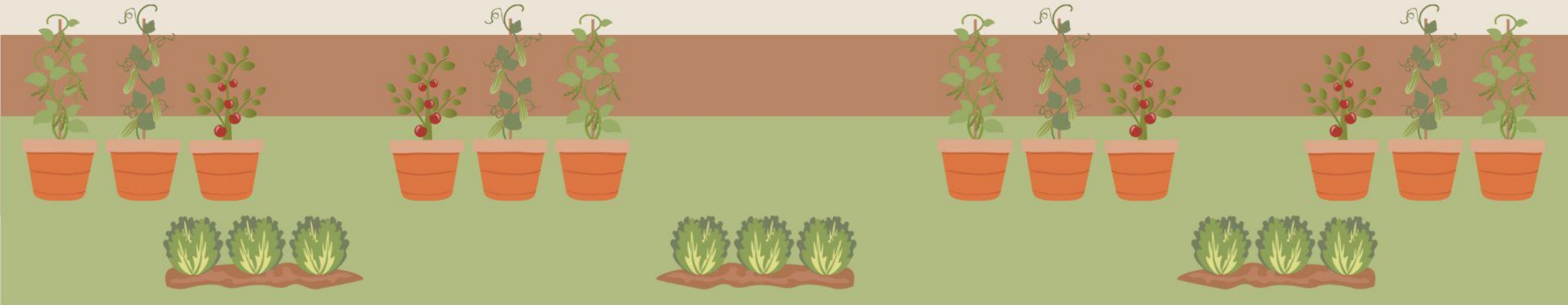

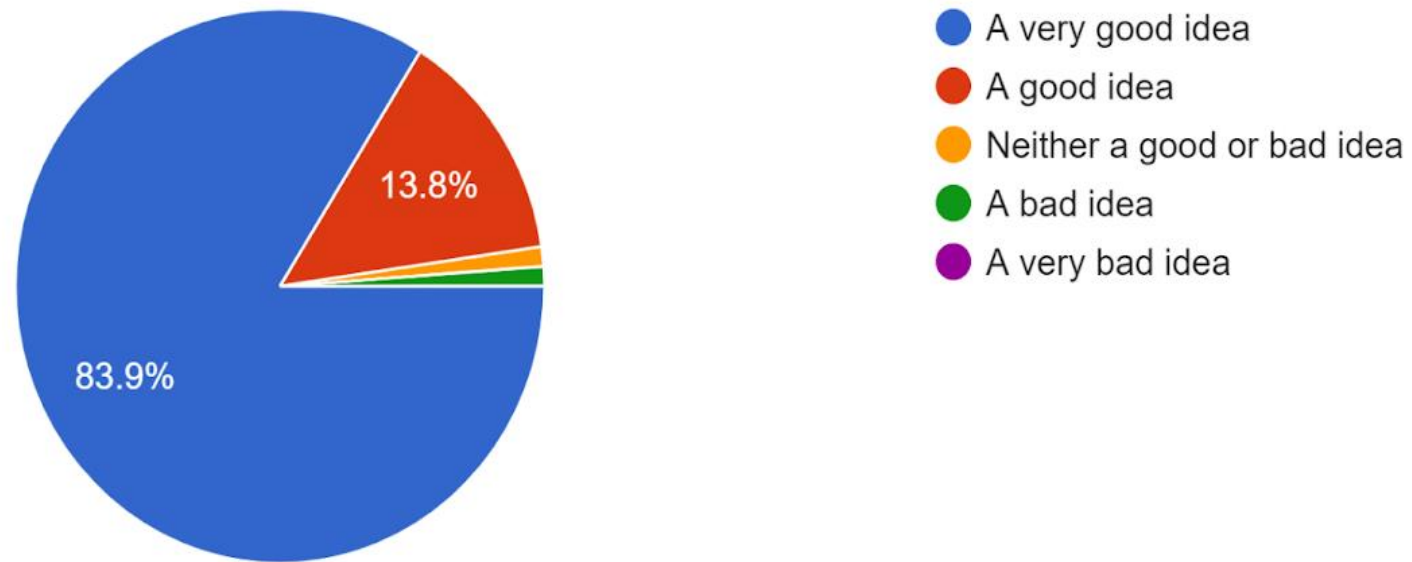


Knightswood Community Centre is seeking to find out how interested the community would be in a community garden space at the Centre.



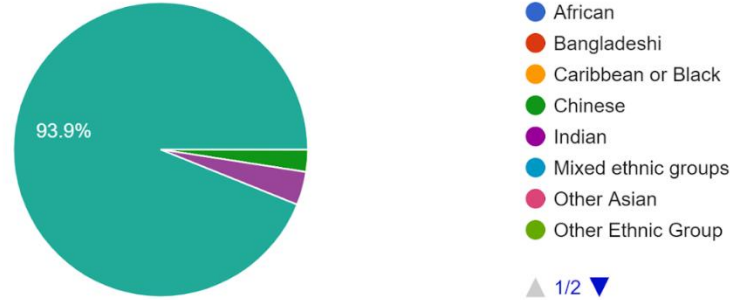
Q1 - Do you think a community garden at Knightswood Centre is a good or bad idea?

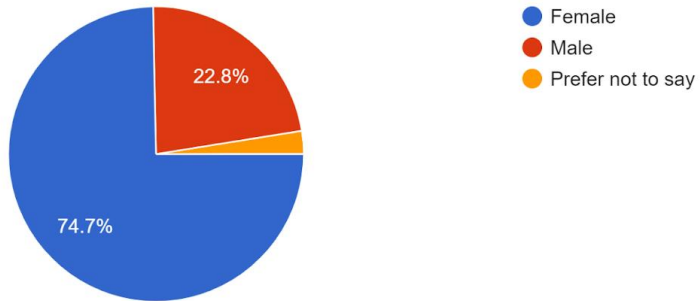




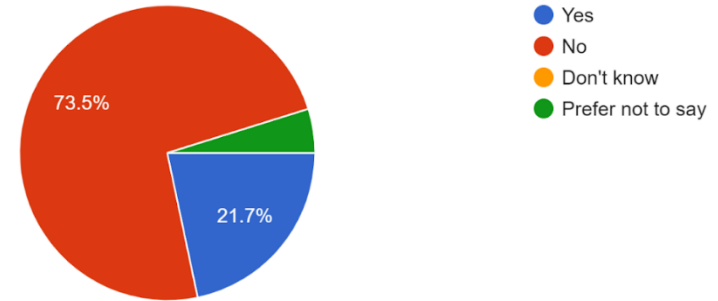
Q16d Please select your ethnicity from this alphabetical list

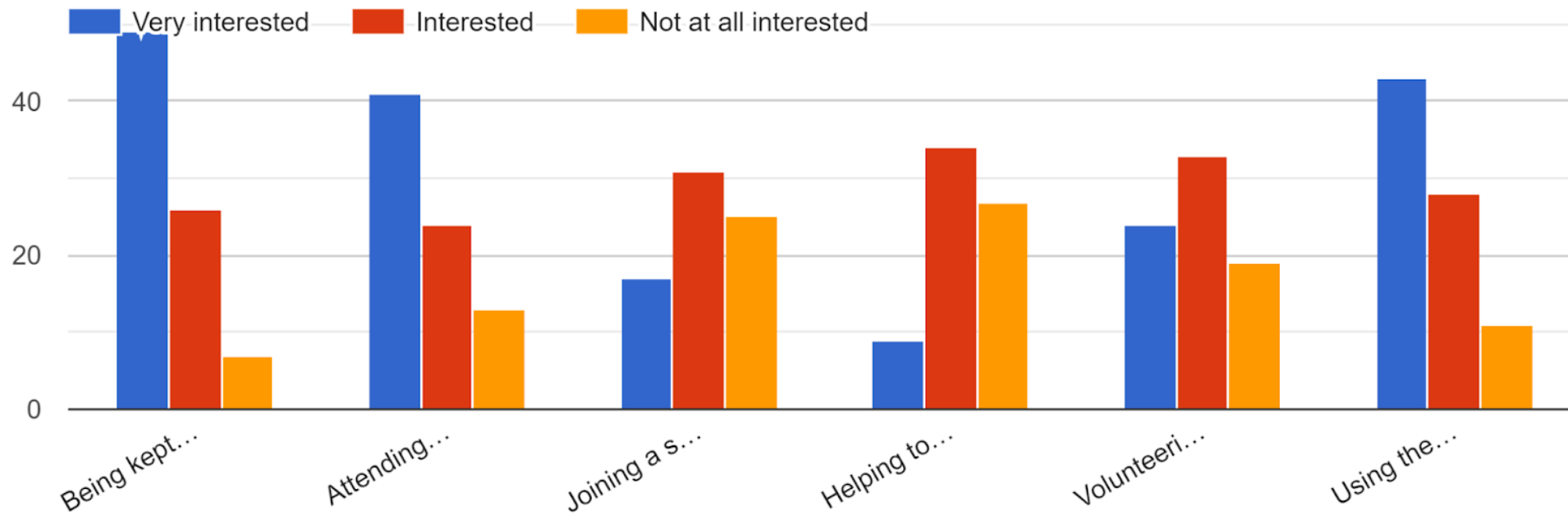

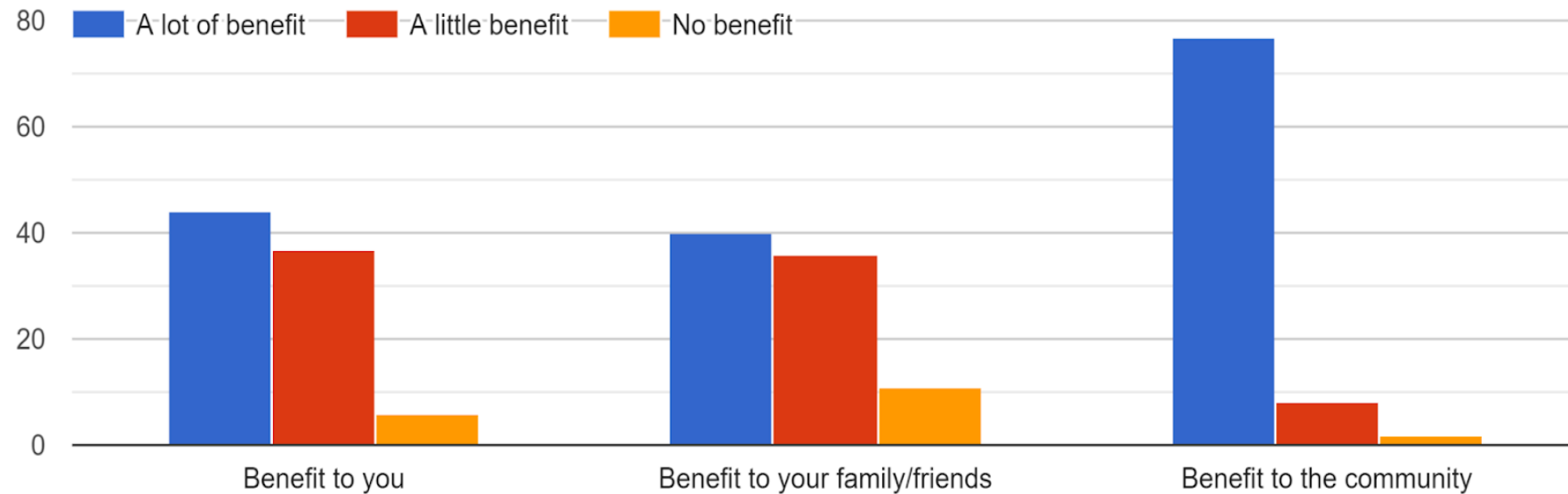


Q6 - Your interest - How interested would you be in being involved in the following?



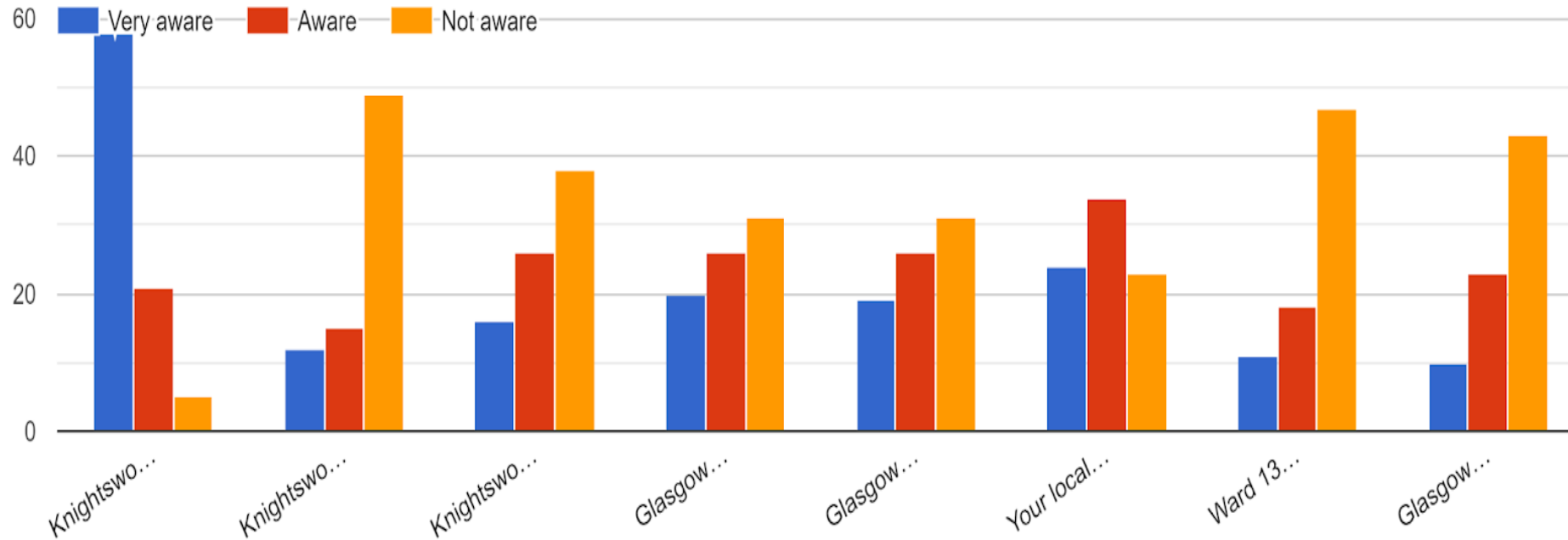


Q3 - Benefit - how much would a community garden benefit you, your family/friends and the community (answer all rows)





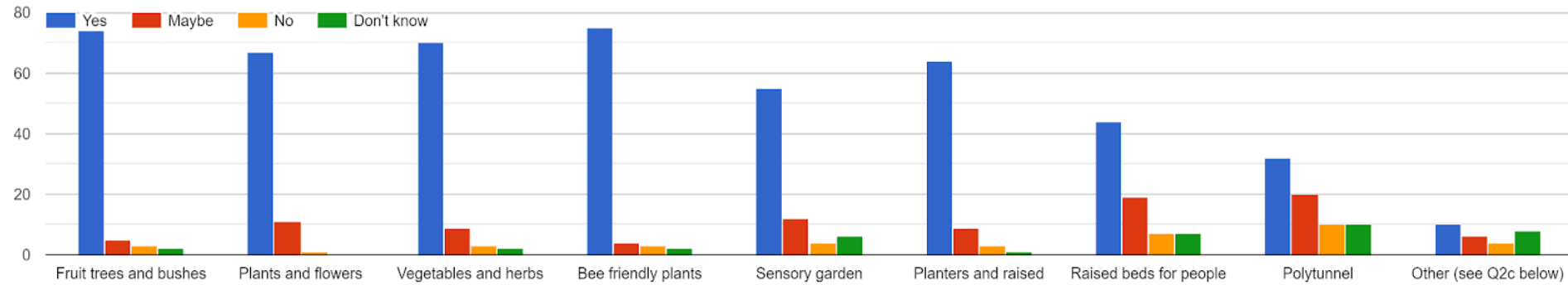

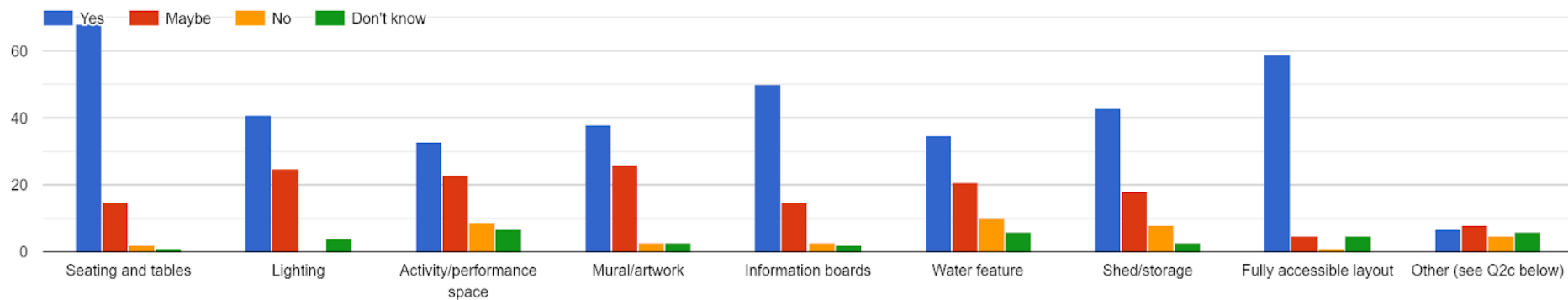

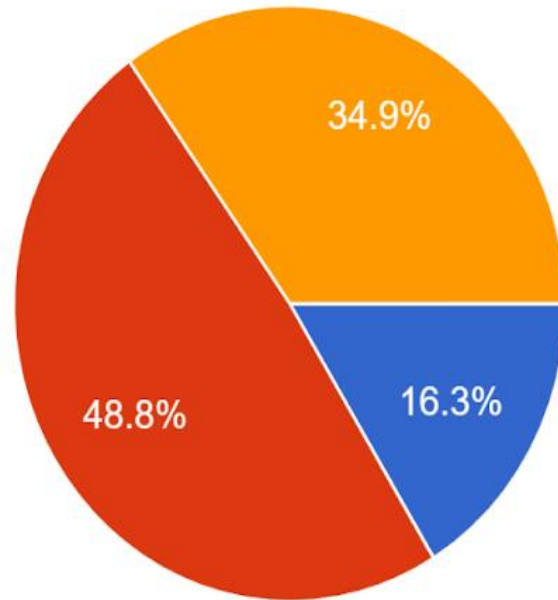
