## Knightswood Community Cinema On the Screen Again Monday Films (All Free)

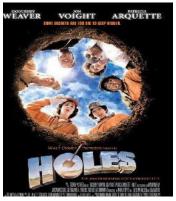

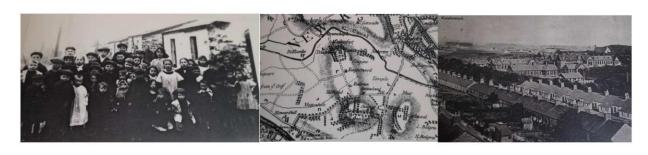
